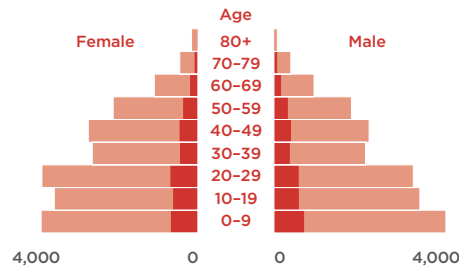


# No one left behind

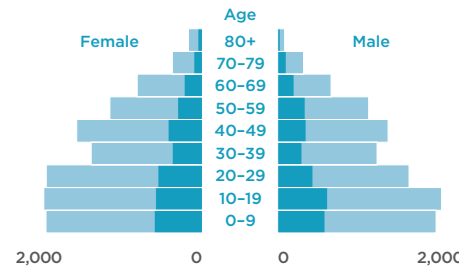
## DIFFERENT HEALTH NEEDS REQUIRE DIFFERENT SERVICES

**Māori**



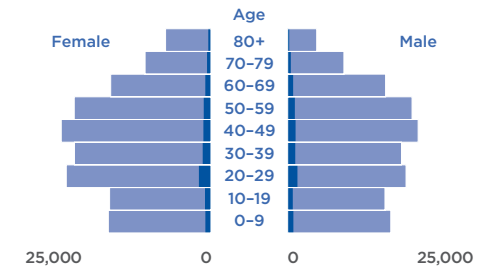
