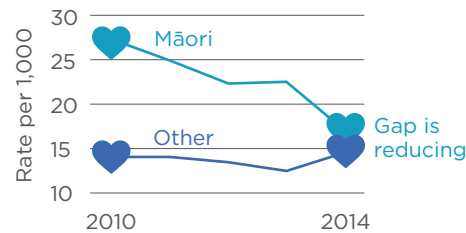
MATERNITY COMES HOME

General practice staff and the LMC consider the pilot a success.

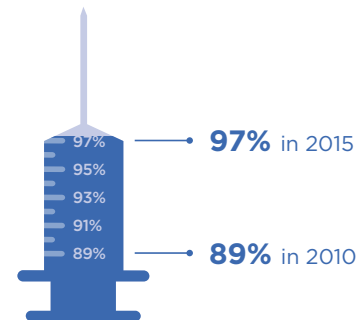
HEART CHECKS FOR MĀORI

Fewer Māori patients have been admitted to hospital for CVD illnesses due to more CVD Risk Assessments being completed over the past five years.



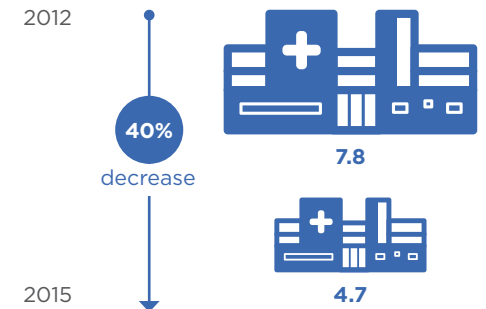
MORE IMMUNISATIONS
